



Errata Sheet

The following are corrections to the Orange County Health Needs Assessment, Spring Report, 1999 as indicated:

1. Access to Health Care Summary, pg. 21, sixth bullet point.
 - ❖ *Item reads:* It is estimated that approximately 30,000 seniors (12%) aged 65 and older are without health care coverage.
 - ❖ *Correction:* It is estimated that approximately 22,000 seniors (8.6%) aged 65 and older are without health care coverage.¹

The following are corrections to the Orange County Health Needs Assessment, Spring Report, 2002 as indicated:

1. Access and Health Status of Mature Adults, 65+, pg. 4-68, first bullet point.
 - ❖ *Item reads:* 1.5%* indicated that they did not have any kind of health care coverage (question included Medicare).
 - ❖ *Correction:* 1.3%* indicated that they did not have any kind of health care coverage (question included Medicare).

(*Note: small numbers of respondents make data unreliable, use only as a reference, do not generalize results to the broader population).
